

#### Multiple Workloads

It's no longer enough for an all-flash array to claim submillisecond latency when running a single workload. The real question is how does it perform when running multiple simultaneous different workloads? What are the sources of latency in addition to the storage system? Where is latency

being measured? My Flash Memory Summit presentation explored these questions.

#### Rethinking the difference between Memory and Storage
